

## MARY B. JORDAN SCHOLARSHIP FAQs

QUESTION	ANSWER
Who is eligible for scholarships?	<p>To be eligible for the scholarship applicants must meet the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada.</li> <li>• Female or female-identified student who has maintained a minimum CGPA of 3.25 in their last year of study or 81% out of 100% where percentage grades are used.</li> <li>• Accepted into a Master Degree program for a business-related field. Some examples: MBA, Master of Business Analytics, Management of Technology MBA, Master of Science in Finance.</li> <li>• Students pursuing a Master Degree part time may be considered.</li> <li>• Demonstrate strong leadership and teamwork skills, community participation and/or involvement on or off campus, including an interest or participation in sports.</li> </ul>
I'm currently in a one-year Master degree and will be completing end of summer (August 2024). Would I still be eligible to apply?	No. In order to be eligible for scholarship, you must be registered for a program and attending classes in the 2025-2026 academic session.
When you ask for minimum CGPA of 3.25, what percentage mark is that based on.	To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must have maintained a minimum CGPA of 3.25 (based on a 4.0 scale) in the previous year of study or 81% out of 100% if your institution used percentages. If your institution uses a different scale, please convert your grades into either a GPA out of 4 or a percentage.
The official transcripts are sent directly from my post-secondary institution. Can I submit the unofficial electronic version?	<p>Yes. You can send the unofficial electronic version of your transcripts as part of your application package, along with the other requirements, which can be found at <a href="http://yvr.ca/scholarships">yvr.ca/scholarships</a>.</p> <p>If you are selected as a finalist for the scholarship, YVR will contact you for a copy of your official transcript.</p>
I graduated, and I am not enrolled in any program. Am I still eligible to apply?	No. To be eligible for the scholarship, you must have been accepted and be attending a Master business program in the 2025-2026 academic session.
